Ramadan program starts 60 minutes before sunset:

- Quran reading circle
- *Magrib* & *isha* prayers
- *Iftar* (breaking of the fast meal)
- *Dua al-Iftitah* reading
- Lecture

Laylitul Qadr Nights (Ramadan 18, 20, & 22): start at *magrib* (*magrib* until dawn on the 22nd)

Significant Ramadan dates:

- 10th- Death Lady Khadijah (as)
- 15th- Birth of Imam Hasan b. Ali (as)
- 16th- Night of *Isra* & *Miraj*
- 17th- Battle of Badr
- 18th- Eve of Imam Ali's (as) fatal injury
- 20th- Eve of Imam Ali's (as) martyrdom

Confirmation of the start and end of Ramadan will be made by the sighting of the new moon.
